Memorandum of Understanding

Christ the King Catholic High School is an academically challenging place of learning that approaches education from a Catholic “mission based” perspective which is holistic in nature. We believe that the formation of the body, mind, and soul are important aspects of growing into an intellectually advanced disciple of the Lord. As such, an in-person educational experience is our primary approach to learning. Notwithstanding this fact, at times distance learning is required for reasons beyond our control. When these challenges present themselves to us, we strive to approach education from either a hybrid or fully distanced learning model. When full in-person instruction is in practice by the school (commonly called Model A), distance learning is not the optimal solution. However, there may be times when parents/guardians request this solution. In order for the distance learning approach to be acceptable to the school, during a Model A session, the following limitations and responsibilities need to be understood and agreed upon:

- The at home educational experience will primarily contain a live stream of the in-person classroom session.
- The lessons will be approached with a teaching style that compliments an in-person learning style.
- It is the responsibility of the at-home student to take notes and complete assignments.
- It is the responsibility of the at-home student to submit assignments, on time and in a fashion that is requested by the teacher.
- It is the responsibility of the at-home student to communicate questions, difficulties and needs to the teacher electronically.
- The student agrees that all summative assessments will need to be taken on the CTK Campus, after school, at a time designated by the administration.
- It is the responsibility of the teacher to respond to student requests in a timely fashion.

- It is the responsibility of the teacher to post grades in a fashion commensurate with other students.
- There is no differential in the tuition scale for at-home instruction.
