- In order to qualify for AP courses, students must go through a rigorous application process of teacher recommendations, assessment benchmarking, standardized test evaluation, and essay writing.
- CTK policy limits the amount of AP courses that students may take: one during sophomore year, and two each during junior and senior year. Occasionally, capable students are allowed to take three AP courses with administrative approval.

STATEMENT ON SCHOOL OPERATING CONDITIONS DUE TO COVID-19

2019-2020 ACADEMIC YEAR

On March 17, 2020, Christ the King Catholic High School moved to a Model C (distance e-learning) instructional platform for the remainder of the academic school year.

- **Educational Model:** CTK utilized a full-time distance learning model, with multiple teaching styles. This included but was not limited to live streaming, flip lessons, pre-recorded presentations, and at-home assignments.
- **One Day Per Week:** Extra help and teacher/student conferences available.
- **Grading:** Unchanged. Full grading scale available to teachers, with formative and summative assessments given.
- **Final Exams:** Available only to students with a GPA of 2.33 or lower.

2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

Christ the King Catholic High School, in conjunction with the Catholic Schools Office - Diocese of Charlotte, will approach the year utilizing a Model A (full in-person) instructional platform.

- **Course Enrollment:** Limited class size; therefore, enrollment in some electives has been limited.
- **Grading Scale, Policies, Academic Rigor and Graduation Requirements:** Unchanged for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- **Service Requirements:** Effective the 2020-2021 academic year, students are required to complete service hours each semester. The number of hours required per semester has been reduced from 8 hours to 6 hours.
