

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE HEALTH ROOM**

### **TO PREPARE FOR THE 2023 - 2024 SCHOOL YEAR**

- Diocese of Charlotte MACS Student Emergency Information Cards must be completed each year. Please look for these forms in August and complete all fields so we can safely care for your student.
- Medication Authorization Forms must be completed each school year and on file in the health room in order for your child to receive over-the-counter or prescription medications at school. This form must be signed by both a parent and a health care provider.
- If your child will self-carry/self-administer and asthma rescue inhaler, insulin or an epinephrine auto auto-injector at school, a Student/Parent/Physician Agreement must be completed, in addition to the Medication Authorization Form.
- These forms, along with the MACS Student Health Record and Sports Physical Forms can be found on the CCHS website.
- The Health Room is stocked with generic Tylenol, Motrin, Benadryl, Sudafed, Antacid, topical ointments to include Neosporin, and Hydrocortisone 1% Cream. We also stock an Epinephrine Auto Injector for general school use.

### **PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF RISING SENIORS**

As of August 1, 2020, NC Immunization Law requires that all students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade receive the MCV4 (Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine) booster dose, if needed. Please provide the Health Room with an updated immunization record prior to the start of school in August.
